

Long Bridge Project Summary

Long Bridge



- New Virginia-owned Long Bridge across the Potomac River will have dedicated passenger rail tracks
- Transforming Rail in Virginia Program will facilitate an increase of the current bridge from two tracks to four
- The new Long Bridge will increase capacity:
 - Over 18,000 new freight and passenger train crossings
 - 1 million trucks taken off the roads
 - 5 million cars taken off the roads
 - Safety improved by reducing crashes

Long Bridge Today

- Two tracks operate at 98% capacity.
- More than 70 passenger, freight and commuter rail lines travel the Long Bridge bottleneck daily, creating slowdowns and stoppages that mean delays for passengers and freight haulers.
- CSXT structure received rehabilitation in October 2016. CSXT maintains Long Bridge in proper railroad condition, and confirms that Long Bridge is sufficient to meet the needs for their railroad customers for the foreseeable future.
