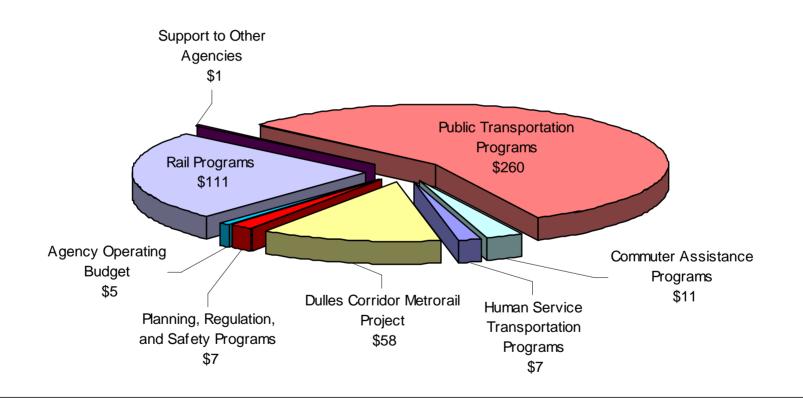
Select Project Expenditures FY 2010 Budget

- Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project Construction

Public Transportation Programs FY 2010 Expenditures

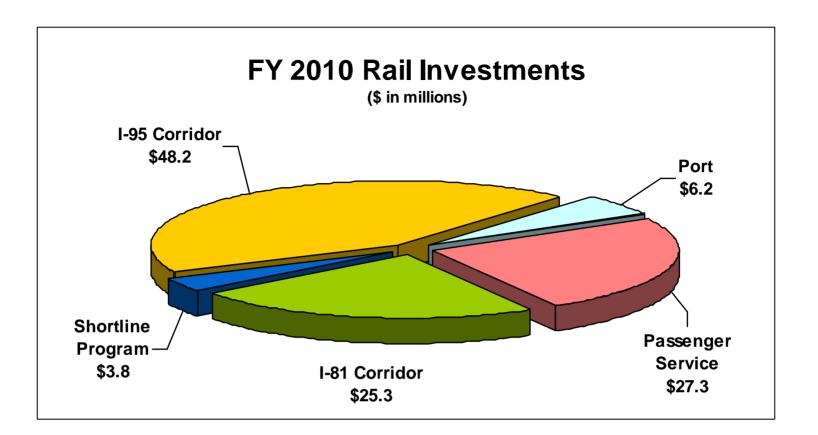
- Increase of \$24.1 million
 - Timing of capital bonds and general funds expenditures
 - Addition of ARRA funded projects
- Detail by Program

Operating Assistance	\$ 122.5 M
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Capital Assistance	\$ 133.7 M
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Special Programs \$ 4.3 M





- > \$110.8 million total {increase of \$13.7 M}
 - Funded by Rail Enhancement, Rail Preservation,
 VTA 2000, Capital Bonds, and FRA



Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project Expenditures – FY 2010

- \$58.0 million total {decrease of \$89.0 M}
 - MWAA transfer complete
 - Includes \$51.4 million transportation capital projects bonds



DRPT Administrative Budget

- > HMO funded \$4.8 million
 - Decrease of \$0.1 M from 2009 for payroll adjustments
 - Primary expenses are payroll, rent, & IT costs
- ▶ Item 448 2009 Appropriation Act \$4.0 million
 - Project development, project administration, and project compliance
 - 2.3% of Mass Transit Trust Fund, Rail Enhancement, Rail Preservation
 - Down from 2.4% in FY 2009
- Combined Project Mgmt and Administrative Budget
 - 2.2 % of total budget without Dulles project

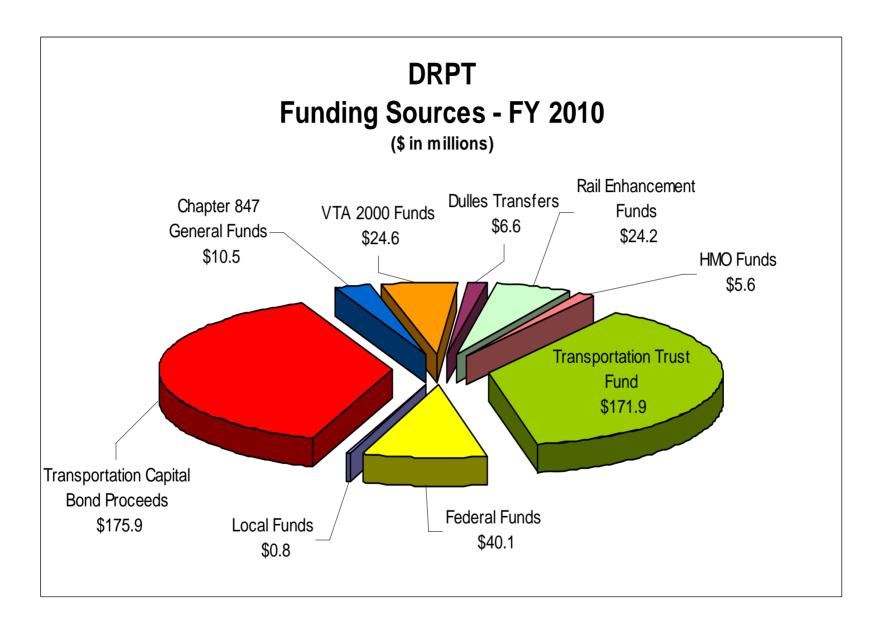


Project Development, Administration and Compliance Activities
