



Status of VA Capital Trail Project


(8) Phases

- A Location and Design Public Hearing was held on Wednesday, April 1, 2009 for the Sherwood Forest Phase of the Virginia Capital Trail Project.
- The project begins 2.26
 miles east of Charles City
 Courthouse and ends
 0.39 miles west of the
 west bank of the
 Chickahominy River






Overview

- The proposed project consists of the design and construction of a 10.378 miles shared use path parallel to Route 5.
- There were 50
 citizens in attendance
 at the public hearing.
- All of the citizens were in favor of the Sherwood Forest Phase Location and Design of the Trail.

Virginia Capital Trail Typical Section





Recommended Trail Location

- North side of Rte 5
- Proposed trail crosses the Judith Stewart Dresser Bridge on the north side
- Takes advantage of utility clearing to minimize tree loss and reduces R/W impacts.



Action Requested

- CTB approval of the location public hearing for the Sherwood Forest Phase of the Virginia Capital Trail
- This approval would authorize VDOT to proceed with development and implementation of the Virginia Capital Trail.



Next Steps

- Authorize R/W Spring 2010
- Construction Advertisement Fall 2010
- Estimated Total cost- \$9,240,000
