<u>Title: Location/Design Public Hearing</u>
Approval for Virginia Capital Trail- Sherwood Forest Phase

WHEREAS, in accordance with the statutes of the Commonwealth of Virginia and policies of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, a Location and Design Hearing was held in the auditorium of the Charles City County Government Building, in Charles City County, Virginia on Wednesday, April 1, 2009 between 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. for the purpose of considering the proposed location of the Virginia Capital Trail Project- Sherwood Forest Phase. The proposed project consists of the design and construction of a shared use path parallel to Route 5. The project begins 2.26 miles east of Charles City Courthouse and ends 0.39 miles west of the west bank of the Chickahominy River, with a length of 10.378 miles.State Project 0005-118-114, P101; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given in advance, and all those present were given a full opportunity to express their opinions and recommendations for or against the proposed project as presented, and their statements being duly recorded; and

WHEREAS, the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the location of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said Location and Design Public Hearing by the Department's Engineers.
