





Roadway Construction

Erickson Avenue - Stone Spring Road / SE Connector

- Number one priority for Harrisonburg and Rockingham County.
- Four lane facility with curb and gutter and multimodal accommodations.
- Designed to improve east west mobility in Harrisonburg with substantial traffic capacity and safety improvements.
- First phase is under construction,
 Phase II contract recently awarded.
- Net long term benefit estimated to be \$430 million with 5,900 long term jobs to be created and 1,400 constructionrelated jobs to be created immediately.
- Vital to continued economic growth and population expansion.



Roadway Construction

Port Republic Road

- Rockingham County.
- Upgrade to four lane with a raised curb median and a 10 foot shared use path on the west side and 5 foot sidewalk on east side.
- Contract awarded in 2010.
 Estimated completion date is January, 2012.
- Improve access to new Rockingham Memorial hospital site and a fire station.
- Improves capacity and mobility to a rapidly developing corridor.
- Raised median provides access control further enhancing mobility.
