Background

• 50/50 matching program

DOT

- FY11 allocations stand at \$15 million state matching funds compared to past 3 previous years of up to \$50 million
- Open to Counties and Cities and Towns (Urban)
 - Application Deadline: June 18, 2010
- Max allocation of \$1 Million per locality
- Allocations provided via tiered approach
 - Revised tier-level approved in 2009 took effect with this program:
 - Tier 1 Project is Locally Administered
 - Tier 2 Locality provides funding greater than required match
 - Tier 3 Acceleration of existing project
 - Tier 4 All other eligible requests
