RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

<u>Title: Through Tractor Truck and Trailer or Semitrailer Combinations in Excess of Twenty-Eight</u> (28) Feet – Route 116 (Jubal Early Highway & Jae Valley Road) <u>Franklin & Roanoke Counties</u>

WHEREAS, in response to a formal request by the Franklin and Roanoke County Boards of Supervisors that Route 116 (Jubal Early Highway & Jae Valley Road) between Route 122 (Booker T. Washington Highway) in Franklin County and Route 809 (Sunnyvale Street) in Roanoke County be considered for restriction of through traffic by tractor truck and trailer or semitrailer combinations in excess of twenty-eight (28) feet pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia, this matter has been carefully reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin and Roanoke County Boards of Supervisors have conducted a public hearing on this requested restriction; and

WHEREAS, a restriction on the proposed route would not present any undue hardship; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given by posting signs requesting written comments and conducting a public hearing soliciting public comments on the proposed restriction; and

WHEREAS, careful consideration has been given to the recommendations received, the available alternate routes and the past practices of the Commonwealth Transportation Board,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia, that Route 116 (Jubal Early Highway & Jae Valley Road) between Route 122 (Booker T. Washington Highway) in Franklin County and Route 809 (Sunnyvale Street) in Roanoke County be prohibited to through traffic of tractor truck and trailer or semitrailer combinations in excess of twenty-eight (28) feet in length.
