RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

February 17, 2010

MOTION

<u>Title</u>: <u>Locality Land Conveyances, Various Streets,</u> <u>City of Williamsburg</u>

WHEREAS, Sections 33.1-149 and 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950) allow the Commonwealth Transportation Board to transfer (convey) to the locality, upon petition of the said locality's governing body, real estate acquired incidental to the construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance or repair of the State Highway System or Secondary System of State Highways, which constitute sections of public road, and upon such transfer, such sections of road shall cease, if required, being a part of the State Highway System or Secondary System of State Highways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Williamsburg (City) has requested by resolution dated January 14, 2010, the conveyance of the real estate for portions of various streets connecting to Route 199, which are in the City's street system, as a result of the City's annexation of lands formerly located within James City County, and were acquired incidental to Route 199, Projects 0199-047-101, RW-201, 0199-137-101, RW-201 and 0199-047-110, RW-201; and

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that in accordance with the provisions of Sections 33.1-149 and 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, said conveyance of the said real estate is approved as set forth and upon conveyance, the roads shall no longer be a part of the State Highway System or the Secondary System of Highways, and the Acting Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, a deed or deeds conveying the real estate subject to such restrictions as may be deemed appropriate.

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
