- Request for Letters of Intent
 - Sent to localities on October 15, 2010
 - Responses were due December 17, 2010
 - 62 localities provided letters of intent
 - 36 localities requested \$1 million
 - Total request was \$45.2 million
 - Based on maximum \$1M per locality per existing Code at that time



Legislative Changes (HB2527/SB1446)

- CTB may provide a matching allocation up to \$200M
 - Prior maximum was \$50M
 - Anticipate FY 2012 allocation of \$50M
- Locality may request up to \$10M
 - Prior maximum was \$1M
- Priority tiers eliminated
 - Priority is given to projects that accelerate projects in the Six-Year Improvement Program or the locality's capital plan
- Guidelines to be established by the CTB
 - Guidelines will indicate how funds will be distributed and administered in light of new legislation



- Current Revenue Sharing Guide is based on CTB Policy
 - Policy was approved by CTB on April 17, 2008
 - Governed the use of revenue-sharing funds pursuant to legislation
 - VDOT Staff updated Guide as needed
- Legislation changes now require the CTB to approve Guidelines
 - Current Revenue Sharing Guide has been modified to reflect new legislation
 - Draft Guidelines emailed to CTB members for review on April 1st
 - Changes in Guidelines since distributed
 - Includes updated CTB resolution
 - Clarifies that prioritization must be given to accelerating projects in the Six-Year
 Improvement Program or the locality's capital plan
 - Adds definition for locality capital plan



- Key changes to Revenue Sharing Guidelines
 - Program and locality maximum funding limits are increased
 - Elimination of prior tiers
 - Funding distribution is established
 - Priority is given to requests that will accelerate projects in the Six-Year Improvement Program or the locality's capital plan
 - Locality's requests for up to \$1M that meet priority criteria will be funded first
 - Locality requests over \$1M up to \$10M that meet priority criteria will be funded next
 - If there is insufficient funding to cover the requests over \$1M that meet above criteria, remaining funds will be pro-rated or allocated as otherwise directed by the Commonwealth Transportation Board

FY12 Program Timeline

- Formal solicitation to localities for FY 2012 applications
 - Call for applications sent to all eligible localities March 17, 2011
 - Application deadline April 29, 2011
- Revenue Sharing Guidelines updated
 - Provided High Level Overview at CTB Workshop-March 16, 2011
 - Draft Revenue Sharing Program Guidelines sent to Board April 1, 2011
 - Present Guidelines for approval at CTB Meeting April 20, 2011
- FY 2012 Program approval
 - May CTB Meeting Review of application responses
 - June CTB Meeting Revenue Sharing selections approved
