

HRBT Project Briefing Requirements of 2010 Va. Acts Ch. 126


- Legislation Passed in 2010 by the General Assembly
- Legislation Applies to PPTA Proposals for Expansion of the HRBT
- VDOT Required to:
 - Make available information pertaining to the existing facility
 - Accept Unsolicited Proposals through September 30, 2010
 - Allow 120 days for submission of competing proposals
 - Make recommendation to CTB whether to advance no more than two proposals to an IRP by May 1, 2011
 - Recommend to the Commissioner by September 1, 2011, whether to execute an interim agreement



HRBT Project Briefing Requirements of 2010 Va. Acts Ch. 126

Current Status:

- Hampton Roads Crossings ("HRC") submitted unsolicited proposal to VDOT on September 29, 2010
- VDOT accepted HRC unsolicited proposal on October 28, 2010, and posted the proposal for competition
- Hampton Roads Mobility Group and Cintra Infraestructuras S.A. submitted competing conceptual proposals prior to the end of the competition period



HRBT Project Briefing VDOT Activities

- VDOT Activities Procurement:
 - Evaluated proposals submitted pursuant to 2010 Va. Acts Ch. 126
- VDOT Activities Environmental:
 - Study I-64 corridor to identify needed transportation improvements
 - Two adjacent environmental studies of I-64 corridor:
 - Peninsula Segment (I-95 to I-664) study currently underway
 - HRBT Segment (I-664 to I-564) study expected to begin in spring 2011
 - Goal is to achieve a Final Environmental Impact Statement for each study, per NEPA process
 - · Better definition of the scope
 - Better definition of the risks (for both VDOT and concessionaire)

- Recommendations for Project Development:
 - Advance none of the three conceptual proposals to an IRP at this time
 - Retain all three conceptual proposals that were submitted pursuant to 2010
 Va. Acts Ch. 126
 - Continue with studies necessary to complete Environmental Impact Statements
 - Continue project development work using processes set forth in Commonwealth's PPTA Implementation Manual and Guidelines, including:
 - High Level and Detailed Level Screenings
 - Value for Money Analysis
 - · Development of Business Case
 - Development of Risk Management Plan
 - Public Outreach



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
