RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD December 5, 2012 <u>MOTION</u>

Title: Through Truck Restriction Route 193 (Georgetown Pike) & Route 686 (Balls Hill Road) Fairfax County

WHEREAS, in response to a formal request by the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors that; Route 193 (Georgetown Pike) between Route I-495 and Route 123 (Dolly Madison Boulevard) and, Route 686 (Balls Hill Road) between Route 738 (Old Dominion Drive) and Route 193 (Georgetown Pike), and Route 686 (Balls Hill Road) between Route 694 (Lewinsville Road) and Route 738 (Old Dominion Drive) in Fairfax County be considered for restriction of through traffic by trucks pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the *Code of Virginia*, this matter has been carefully reviewed; and,

WHEREAS, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors have conducted a public hearing on these requested restrictions; and,

WHEREAS, a restriction on these proposed routes would not present an undue hardship; and.

WHEREAS, proper notice was given by posting signs and publishing notices advising the public of the proposed restrictions and requesting written comments; and,

WHEREAS, careful consideration has been given to the recommendations received, the available alternate routes and the past practices of the Commonwealth Transportation Board,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the *Code of Virginia*, that Route 193 (Georgetown Pike) between Route I-495 and Route 123 (Dolly Madison Boulevard), Route 686 (Balls Hill Road) between Route 738 (Old Dominion Drive) and Route 193 (Georgetown Pike), and Route 686 (Balls Hill Road) between Route 694 (Lewinsville Road) and Route 738 (Old Dominion Drive) in Fairfax County be prohibited to through traffic of trucks.
