


## The Port's Economic Impact

- Cargo worth more than \$41 billion is moved to more than 14,000 U.S. businesses in 48 states
- 343,000 jobs, every 9<sup>th</sup> job in Virginia
  - \$13.5 B in income
  - Total revenues of \$41.1 B



#### **Forecasted Global Demand**


 U.S. containerized cargo traffic will grow at twice the rate of GDP








## Population Centers & 2040 Cargo **Forecasts**





### **Panama Canal Expansion**

- Complete 2014-2015
- Expanded by 400' long, 70' wide, 18' deep
- Ships holding up to 18,000 TEUs will be able to traverse the canal
  - Currently movesships with 4,400 TEUs






#### Port is Poised for Growth

- Virginia has elements of a successful port
  - Unrestricted deep water channels
  - Efficient port infrastructure
  - Efficient inland transportation
- Advantages over competitive ports
  - Other East Coast ports have limited expansion options
  - Virginia is the only port in the U.S. with a permitted expansion project in place




### **Port Channel Depths**







• CSX service began January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012






### Virginia Inland Port

- Generates7,000 jobs






# Inbound and Outbound Daily Trainy Counts
