

At a Glance ...

- Bristol MPO was established in 1982.
- Bi-state MPO.
- Member Jurisdictions:
 - Bristol, VA.
 - Washington County, VA. (part)
 - Bristol, TN
 - Bluff City, TN
 - Sullivan County, TN. (part)
- Population of the current planning region approximately 90,000.

At a Glance ...

- Corridors of Statewide significance, I-81, Route 11, and Route 58.
- Class I Railroad, Norfolk Southern Railway.
- Urban area served by Bristol Virginia Transit and Bristol Tennessee Transit. Rural area transit provided by District III Cooperative Government.
- Currently attainment status for air quality.
- Bristol Long-Range Transportation Plan Year 2035 was adopted in 2011. Next transportation plan update due in 2015.










Census 2010 Urbanized Area Designations

- Significance of Urbanized Area (UZA) Designation
 - Requirement for establishing an MPO (UZA population greater than 50,000).
 - The UZA is the basis for defining the MPO's planning boundary.
 - Many Federal and State funding allocations are based on the UZA population.
- Census 2010 Bristol Tennessee-Virginia Urbanized Area
 - Census 2000 UZA population 58,472.
 - Census 2010 UZA population 69,501.
 - Represents an 18.9% growth in population.
 - Significant impacts to the geography of the MPO planning area.








Census 2010 Urbanized Area Designations

What's Next:

- Coordination with State and local officials for establishing the MPO's Metropolitan Planning Boundary (At a minimum, the MPO planning boundary must include the entire urbanized area).
- Reorganization of the MPO Executive Board and Technical Staff, MPO Prospectus, and By-laws.
- Revisions to the Federal Functional Classification of Highways, and other Federally required planning documents.
- Timeframe for boundary adjustments:
 - Next required update of the long-range transportation plan, or
 - Four years from the Federal Register Notice (whichever is sooner).

- Interstate 81:
 - Bristol City Interchange improvements at Exit 7
 Scope: Reconstruction and added capacity.








Route 11 (Lee Highway):

Scope: Reconstruction and added capacity

- Bristol City Island Rd (Exit 5) to Flannagan Dr (PE Only)
- Bristol City Alexis Dr to Old Airport Rd (PE Only)
- Bristol City Old Airport Road to N. City Limit
- Washington Co. North City Limits to Exit 10 (PE Only)







Highway Safety Improvement Program:

Scope: Bristol City – Signal upgrades

- Euclid Ave and Vance Dr (under construction)
- Commonwealth Ave and Euclid Ave
- Lee Hwy and Valley Dr
- Lee Hwy and Bonham Rd





- Bonham Rd/Linden Dr and Lee Hwy/Alexis Dr:
 - Scope: Bristol City Signalization and relocation of Lee Hwy/Alexis Dr intersection.





- Bristol Virginia Transit:
 - Rolling stock replacement.




- Enhancement Grants
 - Historic Bristol Train Depot renovation
 - Decorative street lights in downtown Bristol



Priority Project Needs

- Route 11 (Lee Highway)
 - ROW and construction funding for on-going phases.
 - Project development for the Route 11 segment in Bristol not included in the current SYIP.
 - Continuation of Lee Highway improvements in Washington County to Abingdon.




Multimodal Project Needs

- Public Transportation
 - Operating and capital assistance for the urban and rural transit providers.
 - Capital funding for route expansion on the Lee Highway corridor.





- Bicycle/Pedestrian Facilities
 - Continue the inclusion of bicycle and pedestrian improvements with all construction/reconstruction projects, were feasible.



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
