






### **FY14 Budget**

# **Budget Implications**

- > Total FY 2014 budget for snow operations is \$157 million:
  - Districts budgeted \$142 million
  - Statewide reserve of \$15 million
- > Currently projecting to exceed snow budget by \$60 to \$70 million
  - Could increase to \$100 million



# **Budget Implications**

- Potential cost containment strategies:
  - Delay advertisement of accelerated secondary paving projects
  - Reduce use of service contracts (excluding snow removal and pothole patching)
  - Reduce/eliminate overtime (excluding snow operations/safety related activities)
  - Limit purchase of materials
  - Delay delivery of new equipment purchases




