Program Overview

• Projects can be:

- Traditional (named business)
- Bonded (speculative)
- <u>Traditional projects</u>: sufficient capital investment is documented prior to expenditure of Program funds
- <u>Bonded projects</u>: provision of appropriate surety allows expenditure of Program funds under condition sufficient capital investment is documented within 5 years
 - require total or partial reimbursement by localities if qualifying investment is not established within 5 years
 - after payback, a locality can seek 50% reimbursement if qualifying investment is established within 2 years


CTB Moratorium on Bonded EDA Projects

- CTB recognized in 2010 that economic downturn impacted the ability of localities to attract qualifying businesses
- Original moratorium approved April 10, 2010 effectively extended period for establishing investment on projects with bonded period terminating between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2012
- Approved June 20, 2012, moratorium was extended an additional 2 years to include bonded projects with bonded period terminating between July 2, 2012 and July 1, 2014

CTB Moratorium on Bonded EDA Projects

DOT

- Allowing current moratorium to expire:
 - 9 projects totaling \$3,484,000 in allocations will require action to recoup funds not justified by investment
- Extending current moratorium 2 years:
 - Will allow above 9 projects additional time to establish investment on projects
 - Will also allow 7 additional projects totaling \$4,375,000 additional time to establish investment
