### <u>Title: Revision to November 12, 2014 Resolution Entitled: Revised Six-Year Improvement</u> <u>Program and Rail and Public Transportation Allocations For Fiscal Years 2015 - 2020</u>

**WHEREAS,** on November 12, 2014 this Board approved the resolution entitled: *Revised Six-Year Improvement Program and Rail and Public Transportation Allocations For Fiscal Years* 2015 - 2020 (the "November 12, 2014 SYIP Resolution"); and

**WHEREAS,** the November 12, 2014 SYIP Resolution, among other things, provided that "the Commonwealth Transportation Board approves the transfer of \$x,xxx,xxx between funding categories to reduce the effects of revenue estimate reductions on operating assistance provided to transit agencies in the Commonwealth" ("action"); and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to a presentation made to the Board by VDOT and DRPT on November 12, 2014, the sum needing to be transferred and approved in the above-referenced action totaled \$11,595,913; and

WHEREAS, said sum was inadvertently omitted from the action.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Commonwealth Transportation Board, that the November 12, 2014 SYIP Resolution is hereby modified so that the above- referenced action reads as follows: "the Commonwealth Transportation Board approves the transfer of \$11,595,913 between funding categories to reduce the effects of revenue estimate reductions on operating assistance provided to transit agencies in the Commonwealth" and that such modification shall have a retroactive effective date of November 12, 2014.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Commonwealth Transportation Board that, in all other respects, the November 12, 2014 SYIP shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
