- Final draft versions of documents are posted at www.p3virginia.org/publications




P3 RISK MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

Goal is to Enhance Accountability and Responsibility

- How to identify risks, quantify probability and potential impact of risks and consider mitigation strategies and allocations
- How to eliminate, avoid, transfer or share risks
- Importance of risk workshops with experienced professionals
- Importance of continuously updated risk register for life of project


Goal is to Tap Experience of Virginians Throughout Project Life-Cycle
