



House Bill 2 – Recommended Scenario and Modifications

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Recommended Package of Projects

Board will consider resolution tomorrow based on the following

- Revised Base Scenario
- Modifications to projects in Culpeper, Northern Virginia, Richmond, Salem, Staunton
- New projects included in the Northern Virginia, Richmond, Salem

Districts with No Changes from Revised Base Scenario

- Bristol District
- Fredericksburg District
- Hampton Roads District
- Lynchburg District

Culpeper District

- Revised scope of Warrenton Interchange to reduce cost from \$43M to \$26M
- Savings moved to I-64 Widening in Richmond District

Northern Virginia District

- Remove funding for Northstar Boulevard project (~\$43M)
- Fully fund Route 7 Phase I widening with District Grant funds
- Fund Route 7 Phase II widening with High Priority Projects and District Grant funds previously used other Route 7 project with reduced HB2 cost of ~\$43M
 - Fairfax County has indicated a willingness to provide up to \$10M in funds for Phase II if needed

Richmond

- Remove funding for I-95/I-64 Roadway Lighting project (~\$10M)
- Fully fund I-95 Broad Street Exit with District Grant funds
- Fund revised scope for I-64 Widening from I-295 to Bottom's Bridge ~\$60M
 - Savings from Warrenton Interchange
 - Savings from Roadway Lighting
 - Unallocated High Priority Projects funds

Salem

- Remove funding from I-81 Safety Improvements in Botetourt County (~\$35M)
- Remove funding for Pepper's Ferry Connector in Christiansburg (\$9.3M)
- Fund Route 460 "S" Curves with District Grant funds from savings on projects in Salem
- Fund I-81 Auxiliary Lane from Exits 141 to 143
 with mix of High Priority Projects and District
 Grant from savings from projects in Salem and
 \$3M in savings from a project in Staunton District

Staunton

- Fund "Full Southern Corridor with Revenue Sharing" instead of "Full Southern Corridor without Revenue Sharing"
- Full Southern Corridor is recommended for \$3M in revenue sharing funds (50% state and 50% local)

Next Steps

- Resolution for Board's consideration on Action Agenda that—
 - Adopts the scenario outlined in this presentation
 - Directs staff to review CTB policy and provide recommendations for the Board's consideration by September
- Programming staff will assign funds to projects based on eligibility and project schedule to develop Six-Year Improvement Program
