**Title: Proposed Discontinuance of a Portion of State Route 779 (Fordson Road) Fairfax County, Virginia**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 33.2-908 of the *Code of Virginia*, the Commonwealth Transportation Board (Board) may discontinue Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) services and jurisdiction over roadways, public landings, or crossings comprising the secondary system of state highways that no longer provide sufficient public convenience to warrant maintenance at the public expense; and

**WHEREAS**, discontinuance of any such element of the secondary system of state highways causes jurisdiction over that portion, which remains a public road, to be returned to the local government within which the facility is located; and

**WHEREAS**, a request was received from the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors for the discontinuance of a portion of Route 779 (Fordson Road) from the prior angle intersection of old Route 779, Route 1408 (Holly Hill Road) and Route 1 (Richmond Highway) proceeding 315 feet south to a new intersection between Route 779 and Route 1, a distance of 0.06 of a mile, and

**WHEREAS**, on behalf of the Board, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, in concert with VDOT, completed the public involvement process prescribed by § 33.1-150 (later recodified as § 33.2-908) of the *Code of Virginia*, by publishing the requisite notices; and

**WHEREAS**, VDOT received no objections to the proposed discontinuance and recommends the road segment be discontinued as maintenance thereof at the public expense is no longer warranted, and

**WHEREAS**, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors requested, by resolution, on May 10, 2011, the discontinuance of the segment of Route 779 (Fordson Road) pursuant to § 33.1-150 (later recodified as § 33.2-908) of the *Code of Virginia*.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, pursuant to § 33.2-908 of the *Code of Virginia*, this Board hereby orders the discontinuance of the segment of Route 779 (Fordson Road) from the prior angle intersection of old Route 779, Route 1408 (Holly Hill Road) and Route 1 (Richmond Highway) proceeding 315 feet south to a new intersection between Route 779 and Route 1, a distance of 0.06 of a mile, as depicted in Attachment A.
