


HB2 Scenario Adjustments


Revised Base Scenario

- Updates congestion score for several new location facilities
- Updates cost for several projects
- Does not recommend funding for any project where the basis of a previous recommendation was based on lack of an environmental impact
- Scenario #2
 - Includes all changes from Revised Base Scenario
 - Eliminates Step 3

Updated Congestion Scores

- Northstar Boulevard in Loudoun County
- Telegraph Road Extension School Summit Road widening in Prince William County
- Westwind Drive in Loudoun County

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Updated Project Costs

- Route 80 in Russell County \$37.7M up from \$5.8M
- Route 869/Route 844 Intersection \$2.4M up from \$2.2M
- Lynch Mill Road/Altavista Elementary School -\$0.9M up from \$0.2M

- Route 58 Climbing Lane Scott County (Partial and Full)
- Route 23 Business Reconstruction Phase I
- Route 23 Business Reconstruction Phase II
- Route 602 Lee Street/Cemetery Road
- South Main/Milnwood Road Intersection
- Route 29 Business sidewalk extension
- Route 60/Route 161 Interchange
- Business Park Access Road
- Route 631 Longhollow Road
- I-81 Exit 247 Improvmeents
- Route 259 S Maryland Road

Next Steps

- March Board selects either Revised Base Scenario
 or Scenario #2
- April to May Public Hearing on Six-Year Improvement Program with HB2 Scenario
- May Vote on changes to the selected Scenario
- June Consider final Six-Year Improvement Program
