## <u>Title: Emergency Authority to Allocate Certain Funds to provide for Supplemental Transit</u> <u>Operations in District 8 related to the March 16 shutdown of WMATA</u>

**WHEREAS,** on March 14, 2016 an electrical incident at the McPherson Square station on the Washington Metropolitan Area Transportation Authority (WMATA) metrorail service, prompted a major reduction in service to and from the Commonwealth, and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2016, the WMATA General Manager announced a 29-hour full shutdown of all metrorail service beginning at 12:00 AM March 16, continuing to 5:00 AM March 17, and;

**WHEREAS,** such closure of service has significant impact to Commonwealth residents and commuters who rely upon Metrorail, Metrobus, and other public transportation services throughout District 8, and;

**WHEREAS,** such closure of service also has significant congestion impacts to state traffic operations on highways and facilities in District 8, and;

**WHEREAS,** public transportation agencies in District 8 have increased service throughout this shutdown and beyond, and;

**WHEREAS,** major safety related closures may have additional travel impacts to District 8 beyond the 29-hour closure;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Commonwealth Transportation Board, hereby grants emergency authority to the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation to allocate grant funding in excess of the \$200,000 level authorized in the FY 2016-21 Six Year Improvement Plan (SYIP) adopted June 17, 2015, to District 8 public transportation authorities to support increased service capacity to alleviate the WMATA Metrorail shutdown with said funding not to exceed \$2,000,000 (two million dollars), and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authority will expire on May 16, 2016, and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation will notify the Commonwealth Transportation Board of grants made under this authority.
