## RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

February 21, 2018

### **MOTION**

<u>Title</u>: <u>Locality Land Conveyance, Atlantic Avenue, City of Virginia Beach</u>

WHEREAS, Section 33.2-907 of the Code of Virginia (1950) allows the Commonwealth Transportation Board to transfer (convey) to a locality, upon petition of the said locality's governing body, real estate acquired incidental to the construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance or repair of the State Highway System, which constitutes a section of public road, and upon such transfer, such section of road shall cease being a part of the State Highway System; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Virginia Beach has requested by resolution dated March 7, 2017 the conveyance of the real estate for a portion of Atlantic Avenue and remnant properties from previous re-alignments of Atlantic Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, this right of way was acquired as Route 60 in Princess Anne County which is now the City of Virginia Beach and part of the urban road system as Atlantic Avenue. The real estate in question is located between 39<sup>th</sup> Street and Pacific Avenue, all as shown on the exhibit entitled, "Plat Showing Property To Be Acquired From Commonwealth Of Virginia By The City Of Virginia Beach" dated September 20, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the conveyance is in connection with a road project by the City in conjunction with an economic development project that will result in the reconfiguration of the northern terminus of Atlantic Avenue and will improve stacking and congestion on Atlantic Avenue as a result of the new development. All of the property to be conveyed will be utilized in the road project; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed conveyance has been reviewed and approved by the State Right of Way and Utilities Director..

**NOW, THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that in accordance with the provisions of Sections 33.2-907 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, conveyance of the real estate shown on the exhibit is approved as set forth and upon conveyance, the roads shall no longer be a part of the State Highway System.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** the Commissioner of Highways is hereby authorized to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, a deed or deeds conveying the real estate subject to such restrictions as may be deemed appropriate and to take such other actions and execute any and all other documents necessary to implement such conveyance.

### CTB Decision Brief

# Atlantic Avenue City of Virginia Beach

**Issue:** Section 33.2-907 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, allows the Commonwealth Transportation Board to transfer (convey) to a locality, upon petition of the locality's governing body, real estate acquired incidental to the construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance or repair of the State Highway System, which constitutes a section of public road, and upon such transfer, such section of road shall cease being a part of the State Highway System.

### **Facts:**

- The City of Virginia Beach has requested by resolution dated March 7, 2017 the conveyance of the real estate for a portion of Atlantic Avenue and remnant properties from previous re-alignments of Atlantic Avenue.
- This right of way was acquired as Route 60 in Princess Anne County which is now the City of Virginia Beach and part of the urban road system as Atlantic Avenue.
- The real estate in question is located between 39<sup>th</sup> Street and Pacific Avenue, all as shown on the exhibit entitled, "Plat Showing Property To Be Acquired From Commonwealth Of Virginia By The City Of Virginia Beach" dated September 20, 2017.
- The conveyance is in connection with a road project by the City in conjunction with an economic development project that will result in the reconfiguration of the northern terminus of Atlantic Avenue and will improve stacking and congestion on Atlantic Avenue as a result of the new development.
- All of the property to be conveyed will be utilized in the road project;
- This proposed conveyance has been reviewed and approved by the State Right of Way and Utilities Director.

**Recommendations:** VDOT recommends that the lands be conveyed to the City of Virginia Beach for public street purposes.

**Action Required by CTB:** The *Code of Virginia* requires a majority vote of the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) authorizing the Commissioner of Highways to execute the deed. The CTB will be presented with a resolution for a formal vote.

**Result, if Approved:** The Commissioner of Highways will be authorized to execute a deed to convey the property and to take such other actions and execute any and all other documents necessary to implement such conveyance.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER 1) TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITY FUND GRANT TO FUND THE PARTIAL REALIGNMENT OF ATLANTIC AVENUE AND 2) TO PETITION THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION BOARD TO TRANSFER CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH

WHEREAS, Cavalier Associates, LLC (the "Developer") is redeveloping the Cavalier Hotel complex (the "Redevelopment") located at the north end of oceanfront resort in the City of Virginia Beach (the "City"). As a part of the Redevelopment, the Developer has requested that the City reconfigure the northern terminus of Atlantic Avenue to a layout as shown on <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a>, attached hereto (the "Road Project");

 WHEREAS, the Road Project would cul-de-sac at Atlantic Avenue south of the existing intersection with Pacific Avenue. Through-traffic currently accessing Pacific Avenue from Atlantic Avenue would now do so from 40<sup>th</sup> Street. This would allow the Developer to construct access to the oceanfront elements of the Redevelopment, which would more efficiently bring traffic into the Redevelopment and reduce stacking and congestion on Atlantic Avenue;

WHEREAS, the City intends to apply to the Commonwealth for a grant from the Transportation Partnership Opportunity Fund ("TPOF") to fund the Road Project. Such funds are available for transportation projects that support certain economic development projects;

WHEREAS, a portion of the area of the Road Project is currently owned by the Commonwealth, specifically the Atlantic Avenue right-of-way and remnant pieces from previous realignments of Atlantic Avenue (the "Commonwealth Property"), as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto. The Commonwealth of Virginia Transportation Board (the "CTB") will not begin the process of transferring title to a locality until that locality formally petitions the CTB pursuant to §33.2-907 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended;

WHEREAS, the remainder of the area of the Road Project is either owned by the City or the Developer. The Developer has agreed to dedicate any necessary property to the City for the Road Project;

WHEREAS, the Developer has represented to the City that the Road Project will allow the Developer to add more meeting and conference space to the Redevelopment;

WHEREAS, if the Road Project is not undertaken, the City will not benefit from added tourism and convention business attributable to the larger meeting and conference space, and the traffic impacts on the general public from the Redevelopment will be greater; and

 WHEREAS, the Road Project provides the opportunity to re-create the appearance of the historical "Grand Lawn" connection between the Cavalier on the Hill and the oceanfront beach club.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH, VIRGINIA:

 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Transportation Partnership Opportunity Fund in the amount of \$2,497,000 for the construction of the Road Project as shown on <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a>, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. That the City Manager is further authorized to petition the Commonwealth of Virginia Transportation Board pursuant to §33.2-907 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to transfer title of the real estate identified as the "Commonwealth Property" on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, to the City of Virginia Beach, and to take such other action as necessary to complete the conveyance of title of the Commonwealth Property to the City of Virginia Beach.

3. That the City Manager, or his authorized designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents on behalf of the City to complete the actions contemplated herein, containing such terms, conditions and modifications as may be acceptable to the City Manager and in a form deemed satisfactory by the City Attorney.




