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FY 2019 – 2024 Financial Plan and Program Update

The General Assembly adjourned without passing a budget for the upcoming biennium, leaving unresolved items that may impact Transportation programs

Since not a SMART SCALE year, the funding outlook can be finalized once budget is passed by the General Assembly

Moving forward with the Six-Year Improvement Program update based on preliminary program funding presented last month



Pending Budget Bill Items

- Unresolved plan for employee bonus, pay raise and/or increases in health insurance employer premiums
- Item 453 #2h Directs \$3,000,000 out of the City of Virginia Beach's Maintenance Payment for a sound barrier along Highway 13 from Route 225 to the entrance to Little Creek Reservoir
- Item 434 #1s Provides additional \$750,000 both years to Virginia Commercial Space Flight Authority for Chincoteague Island Study
- Item 453 #2s Maintenance Payment Adjustment Henrico/Arlington
- Item 3-1.01 #2s Requires an additional \$2,583,531 annually as additional support to the to the Virginia Water Quality Improvement Fund – from the HMOF revenues



Pending Legislation

SB 856 / HB 1539

- Removes the dedication of a share of the Rental Tax from State of Good Repair and directs it to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Capital Fund (approximately \$10 million).
- Provides \$20 million annually from the Northern Virginia Transportation District (NVTD) Fund and Program to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Capital Fund.



FY2019-2024 Six-Year Improvement Program

Development of the Draft FY2019-2024 is underway

- State of Good Repair Program (SGR)
- Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP)
- Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ)
- Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)
- Revenue Sharing Program
- Transportation Alternatives (TA)

SMART SCALE Updates

- Portal is open for Round 3 applications for consideration in FY2020-2025 Update
- Existing projects being reviewed for surpluses post award to release and apply towards Round 3



SYIP Update Schedule

- Present Draft SYIP to CTB in April
- Conduct Public Hearings in April and May
- Adopt Final SYIP in June
- SMART Portal is open for Round 3 SMART SCALE
 - Pre-applications due by June 1
 - Full applications due by August 1
