Recreational Access Projects

- **Virginia Code: 33.2-1510 – Funding for access roads and bikeways to public recreational sites and historical sites**
- **The Recreational Access Program provides localities with allocations to assist in providing adequate access to public recreational and historic sites**
- **The locality’s governing body must pass a Resolution to officially request Recreational Access funding**
- **The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) or the Department of Historic Resources (DHR) must provide a project recommendation letter**
- **Allocation Availability**

	State Operated Facility	Locality Operated Facility
Roadway	\$400,000 (unmatched)	\$250,000 (unmatched), \$100,000 (matched)
Bikeway	\$75,000 (unmatched)	\$60,000 (unmatched), \$15,000 (matched)

Project Location: Alleghany County, Virginia



Recreational Access Request Overview

- **Rose Dale Park totals 14.4 Acres**
- **Roadway improvements are proposed from Route 60 (Midland Trail) to Rose Dale Park's parking area**
 - **This Recreational Access request is for the reconstruction and widening of an existing 0.11 mile long access road**
 - **The existing access road is not wide enough for two vehicles to pass each other safely**
 - **The access road is the main park entrance and services an estimated 80 vehicles per day**
 - **This project has a total estimate of \$250,000**
 - **Project Allocation: \$250,000**
 - **(\$250,000 unmatched)**

Next Steps

- **September 2022 meeting, the CTB will be presented with a Resolution proposing to establish a new Recreational Access Project, RECR-003-703**
- **Following CTB approval, VDOT and Alleghany County will enter into a Standard State-Aid Agreement, which will allow VDOT to administer this project on behalf of the County**
- **VDOT will Administer the Project**
