Budget Overview

- VDOT's Fiscal Year 2003 Budget totals \$3.4 billion
- Major components:

| VDOT Programs | (<u>in millions</u>) \$2,863 |
|-----------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| Mass Transit, Ports, and Airports | \$181 |
| Support to the General Fund | \$332 |
| Support to Other Agencies | <u>\$40</u> \$3,416 |



Major Changes

- Few budget changes made from tentative presented last month
- Key changes:
 - Reduced planned FRAN sale
 - \$204 million to \$179 million
 - Goal of minimizing use of FRANs
 - Planning to prepay required FY2003 management savings in FY2002, providing \$10 million to construction



Major Changes (cont'd)

- Added \$750,000 payment for eVA
 - Virginia's total electronic procurement solution
 - Government to Business procurement website
 - Nongeneral fund agencies are required by the Appropriation Act to contribute

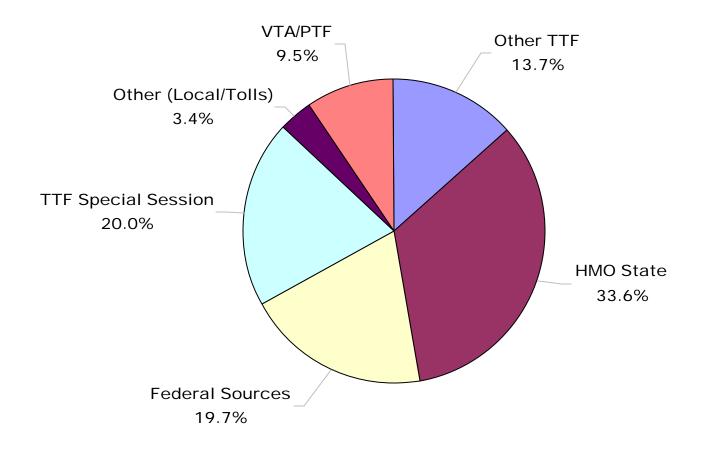

Debt Proceeds

• Anticipate \$542 million in bond proceeds

Allocation of Revenues

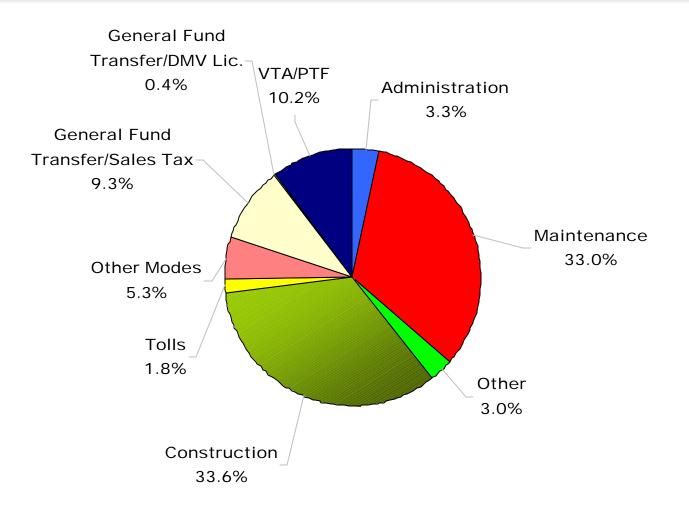

Summary

- Total budget of \$3.4 billion
- Includes \$317 million in state revenues to be transferred to general fund and replace with FRANs
- Includes \$542 million in bond proceeds
- Provides \$1.1 billion for maintenance
- Provides \$1.5 billion for construction
