  - Planning, Regulation & Safety

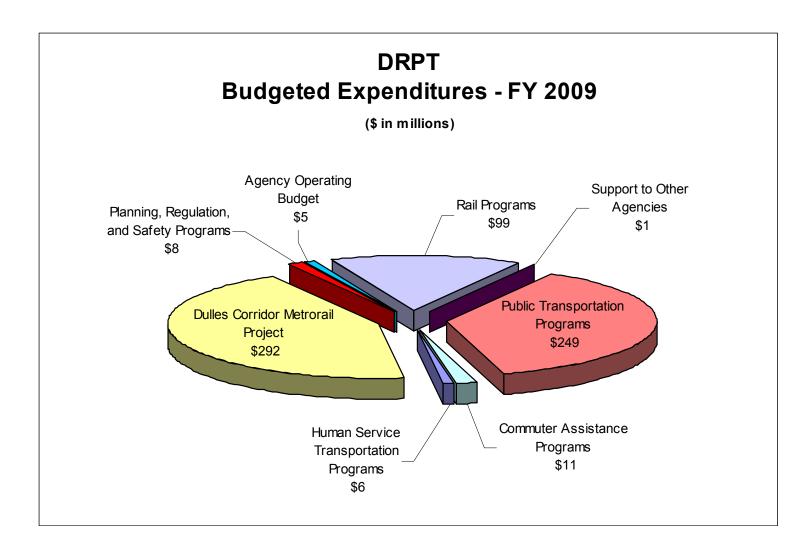

#### Select Project Expenditures FY 2009 Budget

- Norfolk Light Rail Project the 'Tide'
- Greater Richmond Transit Company Bus Rapid Transit
- Infrastructure enhancements to I-95 and I-81 rail
- Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project Final Design
- Virginia Railway Express locomotive acquisition







### Public Transportation Programs FY 2009 Expenditures

- Increase of \$41.0 million
  - Timing of capital bonds and general funds expenditures
  - Addition of recordation taxes to operating assistance program in FY 2009
    - 44% share vs. 59% projected
      - Rising fuel costs
      - Significant decrease in recordation tax revenues
- Detail by Program
  - Operating Assistance \$ 136.7 M
  - Capital Assistance \$103.4 M
  - Special Programs \$9.2 M



### Rail Transportation Programs Expenditures – FY 2009

- \$99.3 million total {increase of \$28.4 M}
  - I-81 and I-95 corridor projects (general funds and VTA 2000 funds)

#### Activity Detail

- Rail Enhancement Programs \$65.2 M
- Preservation Programs\$ 3.5 M
- Richmond–Washington Projects \$30.6 M



### Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project Expenditures – FY 2009

- \$193.2 million total {decrease of \$26.8 M}
  - FTA financial plan
  - MWAA transfer
  - Includes \$125 million transportation capital projects bonds



# **DRPT Administrative Budget**

- HMO funded \$4.9 million
  - increase of \$0.1 M from 2008 for payroll adjustments
  - Payroll, Rent, IT costs
- Item 448 2008 Appropriation Act \$4.6 million
  - Project development, project administration, and project compliance
    - Ongoing funding for strategic initiatives
  - 2.4% of Mass Transit Trust Fund, Rail Enhancement, Rail Preservation
- Combined Project Mgmt and Administrative Budget
  - 2.5 % of total budget without Dulles project
