Background

- 50/50 matching program
- Up to \$100 Million (\$50 M state funds)
 (Based on available funding-\$35Million from bond funds)
- Open to Counties and Cities and Towns (Urban)
- Max allocation of \$1 Million per locality
- Allocations provided via tiered approach

FY 2009 Application Process (Update)

- Applications delayed due to legislative changes
- Application process updated May 2008
- New <u>Guide</u> finalized, posted on web
- Letters sent to localities May 21, 2008
- Applications were due August 1st
