TITLE: <u>Location Approval Raleigh Avenue</u> in the Town of South Hill

WHEREAS, in accordance with the statutes of the Commonwealth of Virginia and policies of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, a notice of willingness to hold a Combined Location and Design Public Hearing was posted. On November 27, 2006 this opportunity to request a hearing was closed with no request for a hearing being received. The purpose of the Raleigh Avenue project is to provide a roadway on new alignment from the intersection of Route 1 and Route 58 to 0.456 mile north of Route 1 and Route 58, State Project U000-301-110, PE101, RW201, C-501; Federal Project STP-530-1 (001); and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given in advance of the department's willingness and no one requested a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the location for Raleigh Avenue as proposed and presented in the plan documentation, be approved for further development.
