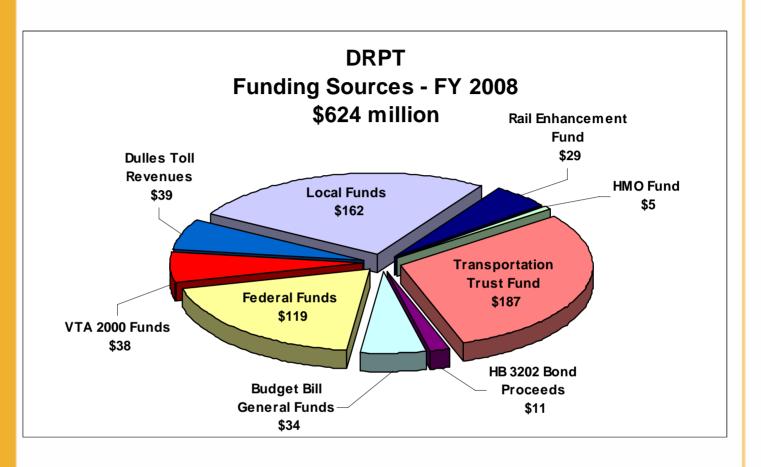

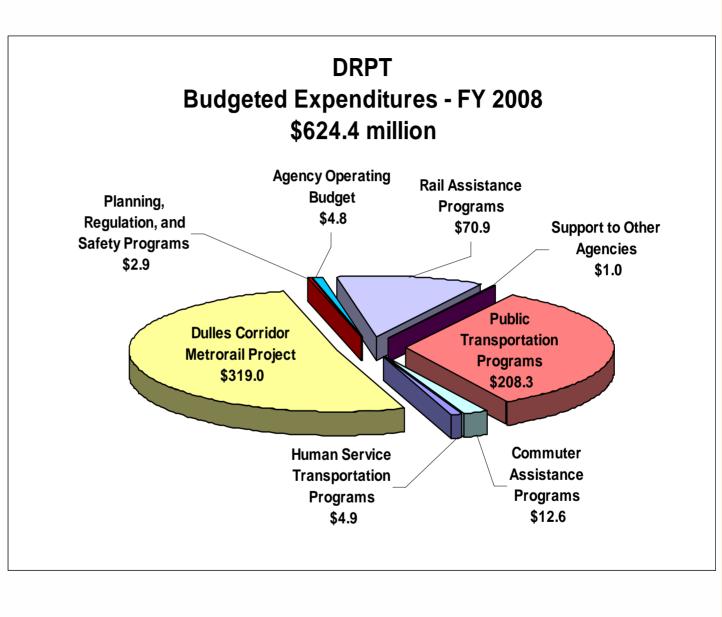

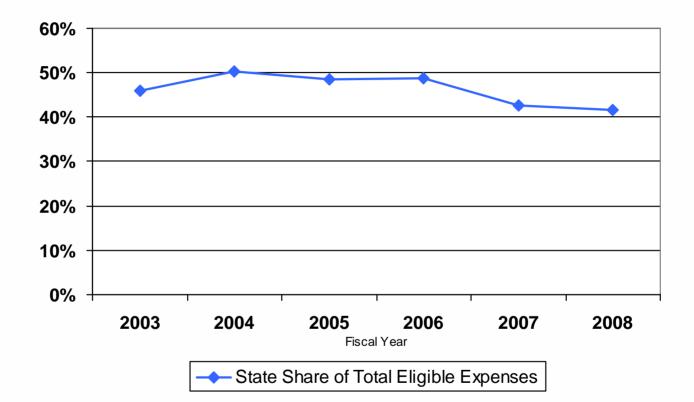

Public Transportation Operating 42% State Share



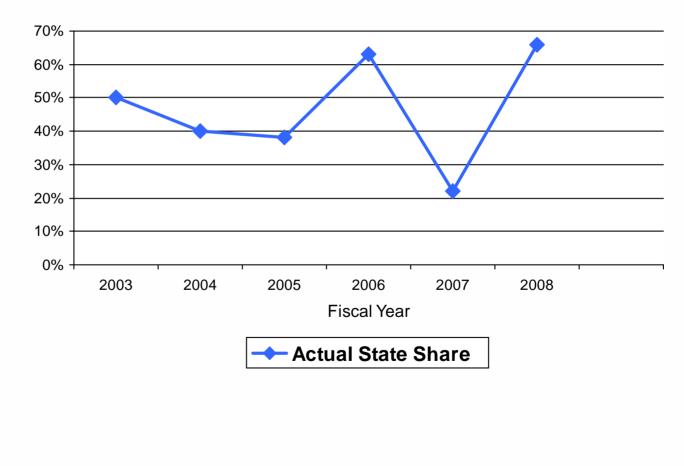
