Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, held in Richmond March 20, 1942.

The State Highway Commission, consisting of Messre. J. A. Anderson, S. W. Rawls, Secretary, Howard C. Rogers and J. F. Wysor, met in the Commission office, Central Highway Office Building, Richmond, at 9:00 A.W., on March 20th, 1942.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by General Anderson, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that the Commission is distressed that its colleague, Kenneth W. Gilpin, has suffered the loss of his mother and the Commission offers to Mr. Gilpin and his family its deepest sympathy. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Hawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the minutes of the meeting of Movember 25, 26, 27 and 25, 1941, be confirmed. Motion parried

Moved by Mr. Rawls, accorded by Mr. Wysor, that the appointment of the following employees of the Hight of May Division as Special Traffic Officers, be confirmed: W. A. Royal, R. R. Hoade, T. W. Ross, R. W. Enothie and S. R. Tompkins. Mr. W. H. Darden having proviously been appointed a traffic officer his appointment of December S, 1941, is hereby cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that Governor Colgate W. Darden, Jr., and Mr. J. F. Mysor, be appointed Special Traffic Officers. Motion carried.

On motion of General Anderson, ascended by Mr. Eawle, the following MESCLUTION was adopted at meeting of the Highway Commission hold on the 20th day of March, 1942;

WHEMEAS, the Homorable John Q. Hhodes, Jr., as Assistant Attorney General, represented the Department of Highways in legal matters from April, 1940, to February, 1942, at which time he was appointed Director of the Dhemployment Compensation Commission by the Homorable Colgate W. Darden, Governor of Virginia; and

WHEMMAS, during that time Mr. Handes most ably handled all legal questions pertaining to the workings of the Departments

The Commission approved the proposed by-pass at South Boston, as shown on a blue print submitted by Mr. Mullen, which would intersect Boute 304 about 500 feet East of the corporate limits of South Boston, then proceeding approximately South until a short distance before reaching the railroad, it then turns west going behind the new high school and coming into Bank Street it leads directly into Main Street.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by General Anderson, that the Commission allocate \$5,000.00 of the Reserve in the 1941-42 additional allocation, to pave a short section of road in the University of Virginia grounds, southeast of the New Engineering Suilding and commenting Houte 29 with the old Lynchburg Road. Moved by Mr. Bawls, escended by Mr. Wysor, that permit No. 15122 S, Houte 611, Buchanan County, issued March 18, 1942, to the Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that parmit No. 8700, Route 60, Princess inne County, issued December 18, 1941, to W.R.M. Moss, Project Superintendent, Seashore State Park, V. S. Department of the Interior, Cape Henry, Vs., be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that permit No. 10586 S, Route 611, Enchanan Couty, issued July 8, 1941, to the Appalachian Electric Power Co., Elucfield, West Va., be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by General Anderson, seconded by Mr. Bawle, that the Commission, after carefully considering the requests for additional mileage to the secondary system, adopt the policy of adding annually two percent (2%) of the total improved mileage in the counties instead of the usual one percent (1%) heretofore approved. Motion carried.

Under the new rule each county will be allowed one percent of its total secondary mileage as of July lat. 1988; and further, when a 50 foot right of way is graded to a width of 22 feet with satisfactory drainage and surfaced with a suitable surface to a width of 15 feet, an additional two percent of such improved roads may be added. It is supposed that only counties adjacent to large centers of population can take advantage of the increase in improved mileage.

Moved by General Anderson, seconded by Mr. Mysor, that the request to add 3.46 miles of Houte 636 in Lee County, between St. Charles and Stone Creek, to the Primary System be approved as of July 1, 1942, under Chapter 285, Section 11B, Acts of 1940. Motion carried.

Howed by General Anderson, seconded by Er. Wysor, that the Commission, after carefully considering the request of the Taxowell County Board of Supervisors to add to the Primary System several secondary roads in Taxowell and Buchanan Counties, totaling a distance of 5.8 miles, decline the request, but that the road being of importance from the Secondary system standpoint improvements when made be from the secondary funds. Motion carried.

Moved by General Anderson, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission, having carefully considered the request of the Taxewell County Board of Supervisors to add to the Primary System Houte 644 from Posshontas to the West Virginia Line, defer action until after July first and the road remain in the Secondary System for the present. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the following Towns having passed proper ordinances requesting the Highway Commission to take over certain Rawles in the towns for maintenance, the same be accepted, including ordinances revised since their acceptance:

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Enwis, that permit No. 10565, Route 11, Shemandosh County, issued November 28, 1941, to the Your of Strasburg, he cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that permit Ho. 15124 S, Routes 628-629, Siles County, issued Hovember 8, 1941, to the Appalachian Electric Power Company, be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

The Germismoner gave a verbal report on legislation emacted by the 1942 Session affecting the Highway Department.

A brief worth report was given the Commission on the Access Roads program.

After conferring with the Public Roads Administration and an inspection on the ground, the Commissioner also gave a brief verbal report on proposed flight strips.
