MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD IN WINCHESTER,
VIRGINIA, APRIL 28, 1927.

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On the morning of April 28th, 1927, the State Highway Commission consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, and H. G. Gilmer, met in Winchester, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting held April 7th were read and it was moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that they be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission take out insurance on the passenger cars belonging to the State, provided the Insurance Companies will not claim exemption from liability due to the fact that the State cannot be sued and give protection to the Commission and other State Highway employees using same, and further that competitive bids be asked for same. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission require of any Bridge Company erecting bridges across the James River, the Nansemond River, and Chuckatuck Creek, to meet the same conditions as provided in the Act of the Legislature chartering the James River Bridge Company. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that when permits are cancelled, due to work not being done, that a charge of \$1.00 be made to cover the time and expense of issuing same. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Masie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Permit #2626 issued to the Inter-Mountain Telephone Company, Bristol, Virginia, August 21, 1926, be cancelled as work was never done and has been abandoned. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Masie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the application of H. C. Watson, Only, Virginia, for a permit to install a gasoline pump in the porch at W. F. Bakers, Rue, Virginia, the porch being within the State's right of way, be rejected as it would create a danger to traffic. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the following permits be granted under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

To Arlington County Board of Supervisors to construct a water supply main along Route 25 from Garrison Road to Outboard Road, a distance of 5490 feet,

To Blue Ridge Terrace, Inc, Charlottesville, Virginia, to place a 4" sewer line 65' along Route 39 and under same at Hotel near top of Blue Ridge Mt.

To Brugh & Epperly, Roanoke, Virginia, to lay a 6" sewer line across Route 10 from filling station just east of Salem,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, to erect 14 poles and 4 guys on State Highway No. 34 near Rue,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, to erect 1 pole at Ammate Avenue Route 39, Elizabeth City County,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, to build one man hole on Route 10 approximately 205' west of Princess Anne C.E. Road Crossing at London Bridge,

To Cushman Brothers, New Market, Virginia, to place a 2" water main along and across Route 23 south of New Market, for a distance of 480 feet,

To Department of Public Works, Bureau of Water, Norfolk, Virginia, to install 2" lead tap under Route 10 to supply water to residence on West Street near Oceana.

To W. F. Donley, Blue Ridge Springs, Virginia, to lay a 1/2" water line across Route 10, 350' west of Blue Ridge Springs, same to be drilled,

To W. E. Doyle, Bedford, Virginia, to construct an entrance into filling station on Route 10, two miles east of Bedford,

To J. S. Halbleib, Brock Hill, Virginia, to lay a 1½" gas and water pipe under Route 31 at Norwood Avenue and Brock Road,

To Loudoun Light & Power Company, Purcellville, Va. to erect 185 poles along Route 36 from west corporate limits of Middleburg to and through Upperville,

To Loudoun Light & Power Company, Purcellville, Virginia, to erect 125 poles along Route 36 from Middleburg to and through Aldie,

To L. G. Meadows, Swift Run, Virginia, to cross Route 17 with 1" water line,

To F. N. Mason, Mason, Virginia, to place a 1½" water line across Route 33 at Station 515, Project 1698, South of Hill Creek Church,

To Town of Narrows, Narrows, Virginia, to lay a 2" water line along Route 23 in the Town from Northview Street east 1700' to corporate limits,

To W. D. O'Neill, Blackwood, Virginia, to lay a 2" water pipe across Route 11 about 3 miles west of Norton between Norton and Appalachia,

To Parksley Coal & Supply Company, Parksley, Virginia, to erect 130 poles along Route 31, from Haysville to Temperanceville,

To Virginia Public Service Company, to erect a transmission line approximately 400 feet south of Benister River Bridge, Route 12,

To Virginia Public Service Company, to erect a transmission line approximately one mile south of Halifax, Route 18.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that it is the opinion of the Commission that no liability in any way is attached to any employee of the State Highway Commission for the accident which happened to R. L. Harrison (Colored) by reason of a highway sign falling from the window of a building in Gordonsville, and striking him, but that to assist him in paying his doctor's bill an allowance of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars will be made, provided he will sign a receipt in full settlement of all claims on account of said accident. Motion carried.
