WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-34 of the Code of Virginia, the Commonwealth Transportation Board may add such roads, bridges and streets as it shall deem proper to the primary system of highways, not to exceed fifty miles during any one year; and

WHERBAS, the Department of Corrections has recently completed construction of the Red Onion Maximum Security Prison and the facility is located on a newly constructed road in the counties of Dickenson and Wise, beginning at State Route 83 and extending 2.75 miles south of State Route 83; and

These deeds are recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Culpeper County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 33.1-155 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the Board of Supervisors of Culpeper County at its meeting held July 1, 1997, abandoned a section of old Route 601; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that a portion of the lands containing 0.657 acre, more or less, and being as shown on a Special Plat for Route 601, lying between the south right of way line of present Route 601 and the south right of way line of old Route 601, from the east right of way line of Route 15 to a point in the lands of the Commonwealth, does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the Secondary System of State Highways; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent landowner has requested that the surplus lands be conveyed.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the conveyance of the said lands, so certified, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, a deed, without warranty, conveying the lands for a consideration satisfactory to the Director of Right of Way and Utilities, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed appropriate.

WHEREAS, the County of Loudoun has reached an agreement with a property owner adjacent to Route 28 to provide for the reconstruction and widening of Route 638 (Nokes Boulevard) and the construction of a new connection of Route 638 to Route 28 at the aforesaid limited access break; and

WHEREAS, the proposed typical section for the reconstruction and widening of Route 638, including turn lanes, requires an access break width greater than eighty feet (80'); and

WHEREAS, the Department has concluded that the proposed typical section will better serve the traffic needs and meets the Department's design criteria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in consideration of the above, the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves an increase in width of the existing limited access break on the east side of Route 28 (Station 189+00 of the plans for Project 0838-053-104, C-502) to one hundred thirty-two feet (132')) in order to accommodate the reconstruction, widening, and connection of Route 638.

Motion carried.

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The Chairman was called out of the room at this point and the Vice-Chairman presided.

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Item 10:

Moved by Mr. Rich, seconded by Mr. White, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221.1:1 of the Code of Virginia declares it to be in the public interest that access railroad tracks and facilities be constructed to certain industrial or commercial sites; and

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors has, by resolution, requested \$91,621 in Industrial Access Railroad Track funds for A. Smith Bowman Distillery, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221.1:1 and is in accordance with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on the use of Industrial Access Railroad Track funds; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the funding formula established by said policy, funding may be allocated to this project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 924, Item 505.A.1., of the 1997 Acts of the General Assembly, funding is provided for Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access projects; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that this project is for the common good of a region of the Commonwealth and serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves that \$91,621 of the Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access Fund be provided to construct new track to serve A. Smith Bowman Distillery, Inc., located in Spotsylvania County contingent upon:

- All necessary right of way and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth.
- 2. All costs above \$91,621, which is allocated herein as an industrial rail access grant, being borne by A. Smith Bowman Distillery, Inc.
- 3. Execution of an agreement acceptable to the Department of Rail and Public Transportation.

Motion carried.

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Item 11:

Moved by Mr. Grubb, seconded by Mr. Lee, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities, and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to licensed, public-use airports; " and

WHEREAS, the Buckingham County Board of Supervisors has, by appropriate resolution, requested Industrial Access Funds to serve the Buckingham County Industrial Park, and said access is estimated to cost \$125,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1 -221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on industrial access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$125,000 of the 1997-98 Fiscal Year Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to the Buckingham County Industrial Park, located in Buckingham County, Project 0802-014-209, N501, contingent upon:

- 1. all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth; and
- 2. the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement, with bond, between Buckingham County (County) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for:
- a. the design, administration, construction and maintenance of this project;
- b. the payment of all inaligible project costs, and of any eligible project costs in excess of this allocation, from sources other than those administered by VDOT;
- c. the provision of an appropriate bond or other acceptable surety device by the County to VDOT, not to expire before December 20, 2000. Such surety device shall provide for reimbursement to VDOT of any expenses incurred by the Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Fund for this project's construction not justified by the eligible capital outlay of industries served by the project. If, by November 20, 2000, qualified industry has not expended or entered into a firm contract to expend at least \$1,250,000 of eligible capital outlay on parcels served exclusively by this project, then an amount equal to 10% of up to \$1,250,000 of eligible capital outlay will be credited toward the

project's allocation. This surety may be released at an earlier date if qualified industry or industries have provided documentation of at least \$1,250,000 in eligible capital outlay.

 VDOT determining eligible capital outlay in accordance with current policy and procedure.

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Moved by Mr. Grubb, seconded by Mr. Lee, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to licensed, public-use airports; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of Supervisors has, by appropriate resolution, requested Industrial Access Funds to serve the Ply-Mould Corporation, located in the Thomas E. Lee Industrial Park in Orange County, and said access is estimated to cost \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of \$33.1-221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on industrial access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$150,000 of the 1997-98 Fiscal Year Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to the Ply-Mould Corporation, located in Orange County, Project 0797-054-216, N501, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth;
- provision of satisfactory documentation of
- eligible capital outlay by the industry; and
  3. payment of all ineligible project costs, and
  of all project costs in excess of this allocation, from sources other than those administered by the Virginia Department of Transportation.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Grubb, seconded by Mr. Lee, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities, and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to licensed, public-use airports;" and

WHEREAS, the Prince George County Board of Supervisors has, by appropriate resolution, requested Industrial Access Funds to serve the Southpoint Business Park, located in Prince George County, and said access is estimated to cost \$645,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1 -221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on industrial access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$450,000 (\$300,000 unmatched and \$150,000 matched) of the 1997-98 Fiscal Year Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to the Southpoint Business Park, located in Prince George County, Project 0730-074-192, C501 and Project 0731-074-193, C501, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth;
- 2. the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement between the County of Prince George (County) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for the design, administration, construction, and maintenance of this project;
- 3, the payment of all ineligible project costs, and of any eligible project costs in excess of this allocation, from sources other than those administered by VDOT;
- 4. the provision of an appropriate bond or other acceptable surety device by the County to VDOT, not to expire before December 20, 2000. Such surety device shall provide for reimbursement to VDOT of any expenses incurred by the Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Fund for this project's construction not justified by the eligible capital outlay of industries constructed or

under firm contract to be constructed on eligible parcels of the Southpoint Business Park. If, by December 20, 2000, qualified industry has not been constructed or entered into firm contract to expend at least \$6,000,000 of eligible capital outlay on parcels served exclusively by this project, then an amount equal to 10% of up to \$3,000,000 and 5% of between \$3,000,000 and \$6,000,000 of eligible capital outlay will be credited toward the project's allocation. This surety may be released at an earlier date if qualified industry, with an expenditure of at least \$6,000,000 in eligible capital outlay, is constructed on an eligible parcel;

5. the provision of the required \$150,000 in matching funds by the County; and

6. VDOT determining eligible capital outlay in accordance with current policy and procedure.

Motion carried.

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Item 12:

Moved by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Grubb, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-12 (4) of the Code of Virginia, to give suitable names to state highways, except such roads as have been or may hereafter be named by the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to name State Route 361 beginning at State Route 83 west of Clintwood in Dickenson County to a point at Red Onion Prison in Wise County in honor of Mr. H. Jack Rose; and

WHEREAS, Mr. H. Jack Rose served in the United States Army from 1950 to 1952; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rose served in the Metropolitan Police Department, Washington D. C., from 1954 until his retirement in 1977; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rose was employed as County Administrator for Dickenson County from 1980 to 1983; and

WHEREAS, he was very actively involved in community service in Dickenson County; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commonwealth Transportation Board to honor this prominent citizen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board does hereby declare that State Route 361 in Dickenson and Wise Counties, as previously described herein, be named the "H. Jack Rose Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriate marker shall be erected by the Department's engineers calling attention to this designation.

Motion carried.

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Item 13:

Moved by Mr. Neale, seconded by Mr. Rich, that

WHEREAS, in response to a formal request by the Frederick County Board of Supervisors that Route 642 (Tasker Road) between Route 522 (Front Royal Pike) and Route 37 be considered for restriction of through truck traffic pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia, this matter has been carefully reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the Frederick County Board of Supervisors has conducted a public hearing on this restriction; and

WHEREAS, the route in question traverses a predominantly non-commercial area; and

WHEREAS, a restriction on the proposed route would not present any undue hardship; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given by posting signs and publishing notices advising the public of the proposed restrictions and requesting written comments; and

. WHEREAS, careful consideration has been given to the recommendations received, the available alternate routes and the past practices of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Route 542 (Tasker Road) between Route 522 (Front Royal Pike) and Route 37 be restricted to through truck traffic in accordance with Section 45.2-809 of the Code of Virginia.

Motion carried.

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Item 14:

Moved by Mr. Roudabush, seconded by Mr. Lee, that the Board approve the report of the Internal Audit Committee which met on October 14, 1997. The Committee reviewed the reports for nine special projects; audits of Professional Services, Access Control Facility, and Cash Control-Dulles Toll Road, Powhite Parkway Extension, and Coleman Bridge; and resolved follow-up, and accepted as adequate the actions taken, or to be taken, on the reports.

The Committee commended the Internal Audit Division for an excellent job on the reports presented and stressed the importance of special projects and keeping an eye on problem areas.

Motion carried.

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The Chairman returned to the meeting at this time.
