

**RESOLUTION NO.12-1000-1141**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING DESIGNATION OF THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOLS SIDEWALK AND PATH PROJECT (VDOT UPC 102851) AS A REVENUE SHARING PROJECT, AND THE REALLOCATION OF REVENUE SHARING FUNDS FROM THE SIDEWALK ON EUCLID AVENUE NORTH OF THE MANASSAS DRIVE PROJECT (VDOT UPC 101301) TO THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOLS SIDEWALK AND PATH PROJECT (VDOT UPC 102851).**

WHEREAS, the City received a Virginia Department of Transportation ("VDOT") administered Federal grant through the SAFE Routes to Schools program to install a sidewalk and path along Euclid Avenue north of Manassas Drive (VDOT UPC 102851) (the "SAFE Routes Project");

WHEREAS, the City is a party to a State Revenue Sharing agreement for the Sidewalk on Euclid Avenue North of Manassas Drive Project (VDOT UPC 101301) (the "Revenue Sharing Project"), a project that encompasses the same transportation goal of providing safe pedestrian travel from the intersection of Blooms Quarry Road and Euclid Avenue to Manassas Park Middle School, encompasses the same scope of work as does the SAFE Routes Project (VDOT UPC 102851), and therefore will no longer be pursued under VDOT UPC 101301;


WHEREAS, preliminary cost estimates for the SAFE Routes Project (VDOT UPC 102851) exceed the total funding amount previously allotted and the project therefore needs additional funds to maintain the current advertisement date; and


WHEREAS, the City's Department of Public Works has requested that funds from the Revenue Sharing Project (VDOT UPC 101301) be reallocated to the SAFE Routes Project (VDOT UPC 102851) to make up the shortfall for that project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Manassas Park, Virginia, meeting in regular session this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2012, requests that VDOT consider and designate the SAFE Routes Project (VDOT UPC 102851) as a Revenue Sharing Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body wishes to reallocate all Revenue Sharing funds, totaling \$425,000, from the Revenue Sharing Project (VDOT UPC 101301) to the SAFE Routes Project (VDOT UPC 102851).
