- **Leverages private & state investment**
 - **Expands Express Lanes**
 - North to the Pentagon (~ 7 miles)
 - South to Fredericksburg (~ 10 miles)
 - Ongoing Reinvestments in Enhance Transit Service
 - Connecting Communities to Jobs
 - Delivering Projects Selected by the Region
 - **Improves Freight, VRE and Amtrak Rail Service**
 - Initiates long-term improvements to Long Bridge (Potomac Crossing) (~ 6 miles)
 - Third track construction in Fairfax County (~ 8 miles)





- **Leverages private & state investment**
 - **Increases Capacity on Interstate General Purpose Lanes**
 - Eliminates bottleneck on I-395 at Duke Street
 - Adds new lanes across Rappahannock
 - **Provides Corridor-Wide Technology and Travel Demand Management**
 - Includes Additional Commuter Parking
 - Supports Technological Advancements
 - Adaptive Ramp Metering
 - **Pavement for Autonomous Vehicle Enhancement (PAVE)**
 - Delivers Rest Area Reconstruction & Truck Parking (Caroline)
 - Safety Enhancements in line with Jason's Law



A FASTLANE Grant Is Integral in Leveraging a \$1.4 B Multi-Modal Program that Delivers:

- Over \$500 million in Private Sector Investment**
- Virginia's investment in the Long Bridge (Phase I)**
- One of the largest Express Lanes networks in the country (~ 50 miles)**

- **Builds on Investments at the Port of Virginia, I-66, I-95 and rail connections to Hampton Roads**
