Title: Naming the Route 612 Bridge (Structure No. 6009) over Copper Creek in Scott County, as the “Edgar Wayne Stapleton Memorial Bridge”

WHEREAS, Edgar Wayne Stapleton’s family lived in the vicinity of the subject bridge during the 1890’s and his descendants continue to do so today; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Stapleton served his country honorably during the Korean War as corporal in the U.S. Army and afterward served Scott County as a Deputy Sheriff in the 1960’s and, for many years, as an elected official of the County; and

WHEREAS, before his death in the 1980’s, he worked for the Holston Defense Corporation and was a member of the American Legion; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Scott County, by proper resolution has petitioned this Board to name the Route 612 Bridge (Structure No. 6009) over Copper Creek in Scott County, the “Edgar Wayne Stapleton Memorial Bridge” and agrees to pay the cost and expense associated with providing and erecting appropriate signs; and

WHEREAS, Virginia Department of Transportation personnel concur with this naming; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to § 33.1-250 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby names the Scott County Route 612 Bridge (Structure No. 6009) over Copper Creek the “Edgar Wayne Stapleton Memorial Bridge” and directs the Department of Transportation to erect appropriate signs to that effect.
