### **RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD**

#### **Title: Limited Access Control Changes Route 171 (Victory Boulevard) between Route 17 and Route 134, York County**

**WHEREAS**, Route 171 (Victory Boulevard), between Route 17 and Route 134, in York County, was designated as a Limited Access Highway by the State Highway and Transportation Commission, predecessor to the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB), on September 15, 1977; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with a section of Route 171, State Highway Project 0171-099-101, RW-201, which is located between the aforesaid locations, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands and limited access easements from various landowners; and

**WHEREAS**, the CTB approved a limited access control change as presented on July 20, 2006, for the land on the north side of the north proposed right of way and limited access line of the said Route 171 (Victory Boulevard), as shown on the plans for State Highway Project 0171-099-101, RW-201, as identified for development to include an entrance onto Route 171 (Victory Boulevard) by the Developer and York County (County), and being approximately 100 feet, more or less, on the north side of the Route 171 (Victory Boulevard) north proposed right of way and limited access line (approximately 50 feet, more or less, on either side of approximate Station 208+30) and being a right in, right out only entrance with deceleration and acceleration lanes as required; and

**WHEREAS**, the Developer was unable to meet the conditions of the CTB approval within the 180 day period as set forth in 24 VAC 30-410-20; and

**WHEREAS**, the Developer has respectfully requested that the CTB reauthorize the original approval for a period of 90 days from today to complete the conditions of the original resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, VDOT has determined that the previously approved proposed limited access control change remains in compliance with and meets the engineering criteria and guidelines set forth in 24 VAC 30-401-10 of the Virginia Administrative Code, and recommends that the Developer be provided the opportunity to meet the conditions of the earlier Resolution approved by the CTB and the conditions as set forth in 24 VAC 30-410-20 within the 90 days requested; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-58 of the *Code of Virginia* (1950), as amended, the CTB hereby reauthorizes the said limited access change for public street purposes as set forth and subject to the original conditions as stated in the July 20, 2006, Resolution. The Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents needed to comply with this resolution.
