Title: Addition of Roanoke Bridge Rehab Project to the Six-Year Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2008 - 2013

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-12 (9)(b) of the *Code of Virginia*, requires the Commonwealth Transportation Board (Board) to adopt by July 1 of each year a Six-Year Improvement Program of anticipated projects and programs and that the Program shall be based on the most recent official revenue forecasts and a debt management policy; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is required by *Code of Virginia* Section 33.1-12 (9) and (11) to administer and allocate funds in the Transportation Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-23.1 of the *Code of Virginia* requires the Board to allocate funds for the construction and improvements on the Interstate, Primary, Urban and Secondary Highway Systems, which was accomplished at the June 21, 2007 meeting; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Roanoke has now requested by Council Resolution dated October 1, 2007 that a project to repaint two I-581 bridges, one over Williamson Road and the other over Kimball Avenue be added to the Fiscal Year 2008-2013 Six Year Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS, there are close out urban formula funds available to accede to the request of the City of Roanoke; and,

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that both projects are appropriate for the efficient movement of people and freight and, therefore, for the common good of the Commonwealth.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commonwealth Transportation Board that the Roanoke Bridge Rehab project is added to the Six-Year Improvement Program of projects and programs for Fiscal Years 2008 through 2013 for the Urban System and is approved.
