**Title: “Deputy Jason Saunders Memorial Bridge” Commemorative Naming
U.S. Route 29 bridges (Structures No. 1030/1089) over the Otter River
Near the Town of Altavista in Campbell County.**

WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Jason Lee Saunders was a dedicated citizen and law enforcement officer serving Campbell County, who also served as a volunteer with the Altavista Fire Department and the Altavista EMS, and was killed on April 3, 2007 as the result of an accident that occurred during a high speed chase while on duty with the Campbell County Sheriff’s Office; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Campbell County and the Town Council of Altavista, by resolutions dated May 19, 2008 and May 13, 2008, respectively, have requested this Board name the U.S. Route 29 bridges (Structures No. 1030/1089) over the Otter River near the Town of Altavista in Campbell County as the “Deputy Jason Saunders Memorial Bridge”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Campbell County in their resolution have agreed to reimburse the Department for the costs and expense associated with providing and erecting appropriate signs; and

WHEREAS, Department managers concur with this proposed naming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to § 33.1-250, Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby names the U.S. Route 29 bridges (Structures No. 1030/1089) over the Otter River near the Town of Altavista in Campbell County the “Deputy Jason Saunders Memorial Bridge” and directs the Department to erect appropriate signs to that effect and to invoice the County of Campbell for the related costs.
