

( Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway  
Commission of Virginia, Held in  
Richmond, June 10, 1932.

On the morning of June 10, 1932, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. E. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, I. Walke Truxtun, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of April 14th, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the State Highway Commission approve of the Forestry Division taking over the following roads for maintenance in the Fort Valley region of the Shenandoah National Forest-

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Bath County Board of Supervisors be advised that it will be satisfactory for the county to proceed with the work on the Millboro Station Road leading from State Highway Route 17, at Asa Wrights Service Station to Millboro Station, after July first. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. East, that the sick leave of Mr. J. G. McGuffin be extended one month with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the location of Route 44 from Danville towards South Boston, be along the first survey, as shown in red on the plans. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the location of Route 28 from Charlottesville-North, follow the original survey, known as the straight line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxtun, that the following permits be approved under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

J. T. Stinson, Barran Springs, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Routes 10 and 213, at intersection of the two routes.

U. S. Bureau of Fisheries, Wytheville, Va., to cross the State Highway with one power line (6900 volts), 2 wires and 1 guy. Route 114 in Wythe County.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Norfolk, Va., to construct single phase 2,3 KV pole line between 145th St. and 155th St., on Route 500 near Cape Henry.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Petersburg, Va., to do work as shown on blue print. No poles to be farther than 2 feet from right of way line. Your Company to be held responsible for any accident that may be caused by doing this work. No trees to be mached in any way. No wires to be closer than 18' to crown of the road at their maximum sag. Route 51 in Chesterfield County.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that gates across the road over Lantz Mountain may be maintained until in the opinion of the Commission public convenience and necessity demand they be removed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxtun, that a permit be granted the Standard Oil Company, to lay a 6" water line and an 8" sewer from city limits of Richmond, on Route 39, easterly for 170 feet to the company's property. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that permit #9147, Henry County, issued the City of Martinsville, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that permit #11175, Prince George County, issued the Virginia Electric and Power Company, Petersburg, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Streets of Williamsburg be taken over for maintenance under the regular maintenance agreement as follows -

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Mantis, that it is felt not advisable, due to curtailment of funds, to have an exhibit at the Virginia State Fair this year. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that if the Commission cannot collect from the Great National Insurance Company the amount of damages assessed Mr. M. B. Hoyt, involving accident with Mr. Charles Goldberger, that Mr. Hoyt be not reimbursed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxtun, that the petition with reference to relocation of Route 55, Lexington-Natural Bridge and Natural Bridge-Fancy Hill, be denied and work be started at once on this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Mr. J. V. Clarke and Mr. E. H. Holmes, Resident Engineers, be appointed Traffic Officers. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Chairman notify Mr. Rawls that the Commission desires a 50 ft. right of way on Route 12 between Franklin and Courtland. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Route 525, Intersection of Route 34 near Bayview towards Kiptopeke, be extended 1.3 miles. Yeas - Messrs. Truxtun, Gilmer and Massie; Nays - Messrs. East and Shirley. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Chairman of the Commission having certified that public safety and convenience require the elimination of the grade crossing of the Washington and Old Dominion Railway on Route 711, across Four Mile Run Valley, by the construction of an overhead bridge; that the total cost of the work will be \$82,700.00, of which \$25,250.00 is to be paid by the Railway Company and the balance by the State, and that after careful consideration of the Chairman's report and the traveling public's safety, do order that this work be done and the Washington and Old Dominion Railway Company be notified to proceed therewith. All in accordance with Chapter 215, Acts of 1928. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that whereas public notice has been given and no objections have been filed to the relocation of State Highway Route 10, between Necessin Gap and Hilton Station, by placing the same to the south side of the Southern Railway Company's tracks, thereby eliminating for state highway traffic -

Crossing No. 1 just east of R. R. Mile Post 41,

Crossing No. 2 just west of R. R. Mile Post 41,

Crossing No. 3 west of R. R. Mile Post 42,

it is deemed that public safety and convenience require that these crossings be closed and it is so ordered. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the location of Route 318, from near Green Bay northerly towards Route 10 be via the ridge route. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for improving Route 10, be carried as far as it follows the present right of way and be cut off where the proposed relocation begins, on Project 562. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. East, that the following distribution of the last half of the Porter-Rhodes mileage be made -
