# Virginia Regional Transit

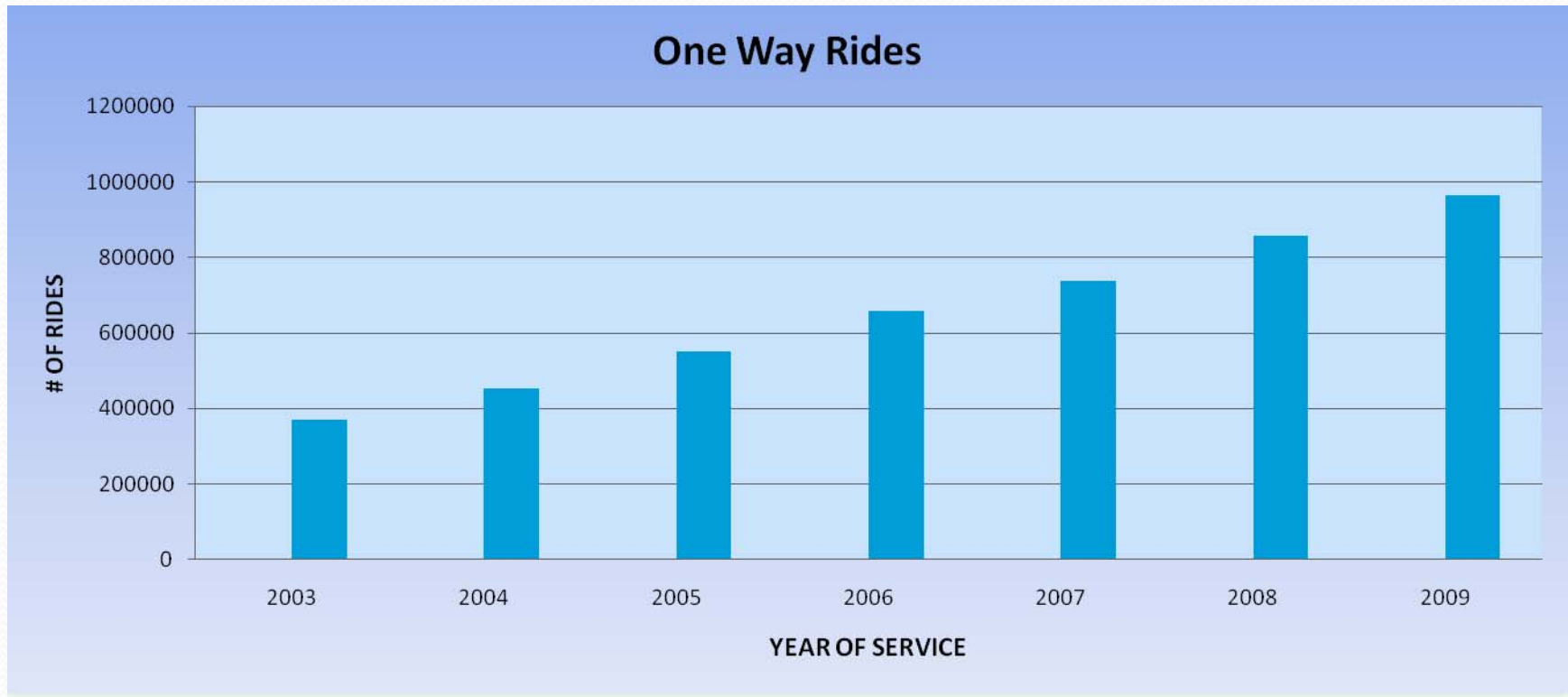
- A Virginia 501 C-3 not-for-profit Corporation - providing public transit to rural and suburban Virginia
