The purpose of this project is to replace the structurally deficient superstructure that carries Rte. 614 over Cranes Nest River, 1.2 Mi. to Int. Route 659. The general scope of work is to replace steel beams, concrete deck, bridge railing, and minor substructure rehabilitation. Route 614 is a two lane secondary located in a rural, mountainous section. The bridge is 787 feet long by 24 feet wide. The proposed superstructure replacement width will be increased to 26'-6" face-to-face of rails. The bridge will remain open during construction. There will be a 10'-0" lane restriction in place during construction. The traffic will be restricted to one-lane roadway controlled by temporary signals.

Design-Build Projects

Henrico County and Charles City County

This ARRA project provides for the design and construction of the New Market Heights Phase of the Virginia Capital Trail between Long Bridge Road in Henrico County and Kimages Road in Charles City County. This phase of the trail will be a 10 foot wide strip of asphalt pavement located parallel to Route 5 with a total project length of approximately 10.5 miles.

Fixed Completion October 30, 2013

This project includes the construction of a new four lane divided, limited access bypass highway to the west of the existing Route 29. The purpose of the project is to relieve congestion on existing Route 29 and to improve through traffic movement. The project limits extend from Route 29/250 Bypass and the North Grounds of the University of Virginia on the south end to the existing Route 29 north of the South Fork Rivanna River on the north end. The proposed project is approximately 6.24 miles in length.

The project will include maintaining existing public crossing roads; modifications to the Route 29/250 Bypass at the southern terminus; and existing Route 29 at the northern terminus; and all modifications to crossings as needed to implement the project. The anticipated scope of work to be performed by the Design-Builder will include but not be limited to the following:

1. Preparation of final project plans for roadways, bridges, structures, ITS and traffic control devices, etc. compliant with VDOT/AASHTO standards
2. Verification of documents provided in the RFP Information Package to include previous environmental clearance documents
3. Acquisition of remaining right of way
4. Applying for and obtaining all permits and approvals as required
5. Performing utility coordination and relocation design
6. Project construction
7. Performing Project Management and Quality Assurance/Quality Control
