A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD NAME THE BUTLER ROAD BRIDGE POSTHUMOUSLY AFTER MR. JAMES GIBBS BROWDER, JR.

WHEREAS, Mr. James Gibbs Browder, Jr., P.E., was a Stafford County resident; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Browder, over the course of his 34-year career with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), served as Deputy Commissioner, Chief Engineer, and Fredericksburg District Administrator; and

WHEREAS, while living and working in Stafford County, Mr. Browder led the successful planning and design of numerous transportation projects, including the \$32 million reconstruction of Butler Road, Cool Spring Road, Deacon Road, and White Oak Road in Stafford County's Chatham Heights area; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to memorialize Mr. Browder's career and to honor his dedication to transportation initiatives in Stafford County by naming a bridge in his honor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stafford County Board of Supervisors on this the 14th day of April, 2015, that it be and hereby does request that the Commonwealth Transportation Board name the Butler Road bridge (just east of Wawa), the "James Gibbs Browder, Jr. Bridge" posthumously for Mr. Browder; and
