

General Assembly High Priority Trails

The Virginia General Assembly identified five priority trails and the Commonwealth Transportation Board allocated up to one million dollars to each of the priority trails for developing project scopes, schedules, and construction estimates.

The priority trails are highlighted in the map below and an overview of the Shenandoah Valley Rail Trail is provided on the right.

- **Location:** Rockingham, Shenandoah and Warren County (Tows of Strasburg, Woodstock, Edinburg, Mt. Jackson, New Market Timberville and Broadway)
- **Start & End Points:** Front Royal to Broadway
- **Length:** 48.5 miles
- **Right of Way Type:** Out of Service Railroad
- **Property Ownership:** TBD
- **Surface Type:** TBD
- **Cost Estimate:** \$100-\$120 Million (April, 2023)
